Corbitt, Shorter, Samuelson, Rodgers & Switzer Inducted

On Saturday, July 11, Ted Corbitt, Bill Rodgers, Joan Samuelson, Frank Shorter and Kathrine Switzer were the first inductees into the National Distance Running Hall of Fame in Utica, New York. These five pioneers in the sport had noteworthy impacts on the development and direction of long distance running in this country and beyond.

Corbitt, a 1952 Olympic marathoner, ran 199 marathons and ultras and helped establish the course certification program in the United States.

Rodgers, 50, a four-time winner of the Boston and New York City Marathons and a 1976 Olympic marathoner, was the #1 ranked marathoner in the world for 1975, 1977 and 1979.

Samuelson (nee Benoit), 41, won the first Women's Olympic Marathon at the Los Angeles Games in 1984 and holds the U.S. marathon record (2:21:21, Chicago 1985).

Shorter, 50, won the Olympic Marathon in Munich 1972 (the first U.S. marathon gold medal since 1908) and at the 1976 Montreal Games, he earned the marathon silver medal. His win in Munich is often cited as one of the catalysts for the "running boom" in America.

Switzer, 51, is best known for being the first woman to 'officially' run the Boston Marathon (1967). She also worked to put women's distance events in the Olympics (3000 meters to the marathon) and currently directs the Avon Running Global Women's Circuit.
